Job Summary: The Building Performance Field Specialist is responsible for collecting field data, performance testing, technical administrative services, and green building certification compliance requirements as directed by the Project Manager. This role consists of inspecting and testing new and existing residential and commercial buildings for energy efficiency measures. The individual is also responsible for researching and completing certification documentation, documenting project progress, and executing efficient client communication.

Responsibilities:

- Work directly in the field with builders and trades, helping them achieve their sustainability goals.
- Field test buildings for energy efficiency performance factors including air leakage testing, duct testing, ventilation, etc..

- Maintain equipment in accordance with company policy and manufacturer's specifications.
- Inspect buildings for compliance with required energy efficient construction and program details in framing, insulation, air barrier, and HVAC.
- Establish a good working relationship with all stakeholders in each project.
- Process data from site visits into reports to the team and completing data analysis in a timely manner.
- Tailor and utilize expert knowledge to meet specific and/or unforeseen circumstances.
