The City of Ann Arbor Office of Sustainability and Innovations has published a Request for Proposal that will be of interest to you!

The City of Ann Arbor is seeking the services of DOE Certified HES Assessors to support the City's Home Energy Rating Disclosure (HERD) ordinance. HES Assessors will perform HES Assessments and generate home scores within the city limits of Ann Arbor and be compensated by the City of Ann Arbor directly for these services, thus making no-cost assessments available to residents.

Respondents to this RFP do not have to be a DOE certified HES Assessor currently but they must be able to obtain this certification by March 4, 2024. This certification can be reasonably obtained within this time frame if offeror already holds [a relevant credential](#) required for certification.
