A successful Healthy Homes Case Manager candidate has a bachelor degree in Social Work or related field (Psychology, Public Health, etc) with experience providing housing, environmental health or public health assistance, linkage to community resources, screening clients, and writing skills (case notes). This candidate will conduct detailed home visits to assess the family living environment to determine the need and develop environmental reports that identify safety hazards and conditions that affect the health and quality of life for individuals and families. After the assessment, education, cleaning kits, and vendor services will be coordinated and provided by the Case Manager. Uniforms, training, and equipment is provided.

Our compressed work week, Monday –Thursday from 8:00 am -6:00 pm, with an hour lunch, is the first step to supporting our team members with a work-life balance. You will have immediate access to holiday pay, Financial Wellness and Employee Assistance Programs. Our benefits: medical, dental, vision, short and long term disability, voluntary life, supplemental insurance, and flexible spending account are effective the first month after the date of hire. Our rich retirement plan matches 5% of our team members' gross earnings with an additional 2% match is available after six month of employment.
