

## Energy Services Technician I

Community Action Opportunities is seeking an Energy Service Technician I to perform prescribed general heat loss and air infiltration improvements that will increase energy efficiency as well as correct health and safety threats on homes in the agency's eight-county service area.

### **Responsibilities**

- Perform and interpret home diagnostic tests such as the blower door and combustion analyzer
- Seal and insulate duct work in attics and crawlspaces
- Complete air sealing in attics and crawlspaces
- Maintain daily activity record
- Apply insulation materials such as loose, blanket, board, and foam insulation to attics, crawl spaces, basements, or walls
- Replace doors and windows

### **Requires**

- High school diploma or GED
- Valid North Carolina Driver License
- Ability to travel throughout eight-county service area
- Capacity to perform heavy work exerting up to 50 pounds of force occasionally
- Pass pre-employment background, drug and alcohol screenings
- Pass pre-employment pulmonary function test

### **Additional Requirements**

- Obtain Lead Renovator and Asbestos O&M certifications as well as complete OSHA 10-hour training within first three months of employment
