As an Energy Efficiency Technician, you will perform upgrades to the homes of our Habitat families to help improve health, safety, and comfort while lowering energy usage. This is an entry-level role where you will develop knowledge and skills related to the weatherization of residential homes.

Requirements

ESSENTIAL DUTIES:

- Performs skilled work on each home including but not limited to: weather-stripping, caulking, carpentry, drywall repair, installation of insulation products, door and window repair and replacement, ductwork sealing and repair, storm window installation, and other necessary weatherization improvements on the homes:
- Accurately accounts for all materials used on each project and provides proper documentation on required paperwork and in project management software;
- Work is often performed in adverse weather conditions such as extreme heat and cold, and in unconventional areas such as attics and crawl spaces where the required clearance may be 24 inches;
- Nature of work requires some exposure to dirty conditions and hazardous materials such as fiberglass, asbestos and lead-based paint; to minimize these exposures you must be able to safely function over extended periods while wearing personal protective equipment, including full-face respirator;

REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES:

- Ability to effectively communicate with clients, co-workers, managers, subcontractors and vendors;
- BPI Certification required and or the ability to acquire within one (1) year of position start date;
- Knowledge of basic mathematical skills;
- Understanding of residential construction techniques, some knowledge of energy conservation techniques
 and practices, and a working knowledge of tools and materials required to accomplish weatherization
 improvements is beneficial, but not required;

REQUIREMENTS:

- Valid Nebraska driver's license;
- High school diploma or GED equivalent;
- Ability to frequently lift, carry, push and pull up to 50 lb. of insulation materials, oftentimes in a repetitive manner;
- Oral and auditory capacity enabling interpersonal communication;
- Ability to safely operate company vehicles and equipment;
- Constant use of eye, hand and finger coordination while using tools and machinery
