

Position: Lead Energy Audit Technician

Position Summary- The role includes completing walk through energy assessments, the installation of energy efficiency equipment and products, and for deepening customer awareness of and participation in rebate programs and the Utility's efficiency programs.

Certifications Required:

Must have BPI Building Analyst and Building Envelope, as well as lead certification

Minimum one (1) year experience in the energy field is preferred.

Duties and Responsibilities

- *Promote the energy efficiency program to customers through the completion of scheduled energy assessments
- *Deliver professional, high quality services to customers
- *Complete walk-through energy assessments of properties that identify the key savings opportunities (all living space, basement, attic, and exterior perimeter of homes/buildings)
- * Install energy savings devices including, but not limited, to faucet aerators, shower heads, pipe wrap, door sweeps, weather stripping, caulking and foam
- *Clearly explain and articulate energy assessment findings to the home owner including explanation of energy efficiency rebates
- *Identify and provide documentation of on-site opportunities for energy efficiency and provide follow up to customers as required
- *Enter data into droid to determine energy savings and to manage current projects.
- *Be able to work in a team atmosphere, and willing to collaborate on continuous improvement of operations year after year
- *Conduct inventory counts and submit inventory reports as required by management

Skills, Knowledge, and Abilities

- *Strong interpersonal and communications skills
- *Strong data entry skills in entering information into tracking systems/databases
- *Ability to communicate effectively, both verbally and in writing with customers, clients and employees
- *Knowledge of mathematical concepts such as fractions, percentages, and ratios
- *Valid driver's license and ability to pass a standard background check
