As an Energy Auditor you will work with the Energy Conservation Department team to improve the energy efficiency of homes which qualify for our program. The Energy Auditors travel to clients homes, interview the clients, conduct a full energy audit, develop a scope of work, work with subcontractors to assure a quality install and helps keep detailed client files. Our auditors must communicate effectively with a wide variety of clients, able to balance competing demands, be self-motivated, able to work in confined spaces such as attics and crawl spaces, willing to use technology and have a desire to make a difference in the community.

Project:HOMES is a non-profit housing agency dedicated to Improving Lives by Improving Homes. For the past 25 years we have served Richmond, Virginia and twelve surrounding counties by weatherizing the home to make it safer, more energy efficient and to reduce carbon footprint.
