Training will be provided to achieve required Weatherization certifications, and it will be necessary to complete those pieces of training within approximately 180 days of hire date. Must possess a valid driver's license and vehicle insurance and be able to travel both locally and outof-area as necessary. Travel may require overnight stays. Agency vehicle provided to travel to surrounding counties. Applicants must meet requirements for criminal history and sex offender registry checks. A minimum of a high school diploma or equivalent is required, plus two (2) years' experience in a construction-related field is preferred. A technical degree/trade certification in a construction-related field may be considered in place of the experience requirement.

Position requires constant positioning of self and to be in a stationary position for periods of time. Position also requires the ability to operate tools and equipment to perform job duties. The ability to lift heavy items, ascend/descend stairs and ladders, and work in tight spaces. The ability to stand for an extended period of time, bend, stoop, lift, move or transport items, traverse as needed, and operate standard office equipment is required. Position involves exposure to weather conditions, mechanical hazards, and hazardous materials.
