

This position oversees all aspects of the Federal Low-Income Weatherization Assistance Program (WAP). It is responsible for implementing the program on a statewide basis and ensuring local compliance with State and Federal legal requirements. It is responsible for the supervision of key Department of Commerce staff in the analysis and evaluation of service providers across the State of Minnesota with priority on ensuring the proper use of federal taxpayer dollars in order to prevent waste fraud or abuse. This position designs and implements operational policies, measures results of the local and state program efforts, advises on development of legislation, and is responsible for identifying, soliciting, and maintaining a statewide system of both local service providers and electronic reporting.
